FRANSCHHOEK

The foodie capital of the Cape Winelands, Franschhoek needs little by way of introduction. It's vibey, busy, an easy day visit from Cape Town, and the quintessential ambassador for the winelands' towns, a title it shares only, perhaps, with Stellenbosch. The main road through town is a hive of activity – restaurants, historical buildings, wineland tours and coffee shops.

HERMANUS

The whale capital of the Western Cape, Hermanus has a cliff path alongside the sea that runs the length of town from the harbour and is downright incredible to walk.
