A beautiful site, which initially received the name of Bay of Beauty by the Portuguese navigators, it is nowadays frequently compared to Monaco for the sophistication and singular touristic quality offered here. Miles and miles of crystalline beaches, water sports, safaris or wine tastings are some of the experiences one can enjoy in this naturally blessed spot.

This is one of the largest animal parks in the Southern Cape region, about 12 km from Plettenberg Bay.
